Departure After School

Unless supervised it is expected that upon dismissal from school, our students go to their after-school care to check in with their caregiver. Unsupervised students should not remain at school to play. Additionally, if any of our students are returning to school in the evenings it is highly suggested that they enjoy their time on our play equipment with supervision present.
